Charles See serves as Assistant Deputy Chancellor of Board and External Relations for the Ohio Board of Regents. In this role, he acts as principal liaison to the Chancellor's advisory board (Ohio Board of Regents) assisting the Board on behalf of the Chancellor to: analyze higher education issues in order to facilitate their advisory responsibilities and produce its Annual Report on the Condition of Higher Education. Further responsibilities in this position include developing initiatives to educate Ohio's college and university trustees on issues affecting higher education and leading processes with external stakeholders to develop, understand and implement higher education policy. Additionally Charles serves as the Chancellor's Executive Liaison and Board designee to the Ohio Tuition Trust Authority and works extensively on joint education initiatives between the Ohio Board of Regents and the Ohio Department of Education.

Charles also served as the Interim Assistant Deputy Chancellor for P-16 Education Technology. In that position, Charles had supervisory responsibility over the Chancellor's Technology Consortium which included: OhioLINK, the Ohio Academic Resource Network (OARnet), the Ohio Supercomputer Center, and the Electronic Student Services Division.

Prior to joining the Ohio Board of Regents, Charles was employed by the Ohio Department of Education, serving as the Department's Deputy Chief of Staff. As Deputy Chief, Charles acted as the Department's Contract Administrator, Executive Liaison to urban school districts, Chief Lobbyist, and Supervisor of the Department's state and federal legislative liaisons.

Charles has also served as an Assistant Attorney General for the state of Ohio, and as an Assistant County Prosecutor in Cuyahoga County.

Charles received his B.A. in Political Science from The Ohio State University in 1987 and his Juris Doctorate from Capital University Law School in 1991.
